Students must be pursuing higher education at an accredited institution of higher learning (i.e., community college, university, vocational/technical). The applicants must submit a photo/headshot, an official transcript, two letters of recommendation (one letter must be from a teacher or guidance counselor), and a 300-word student essay. Complete application packets must be received via email by 11:59 pm on April 2, 2024.

Winners, parents, and other guests must be present for the award presentation during a virtual ceremony scheduled for **May 4, 2024.** Additional presentation information will be provided closer to the program date.

<u>√</u> 3.	An official high school transcript. (The transcript must be the original document issued by the school, bearing a raised school seal.)
<u>√</u> 4.	Two letters of recommendation submitted by persons other than relatives. These letters can be from church affiliates, teachers, counselors, or community members. However, one of the two letters <u>must</u> be from a schoolteacher or counselor.
<u>√</u> 5.	A complete list of your community service involvement.
<u>√</u> 6.	A student essay, 300 words, typed, grammatically correct, neat, and clear in its expression of ideas. Your essay should describe "the importance of being a visionary woman". Be sure to highlight the individual's accomplishments and your vision of leadership in your future.
<u>√</u> 7.	Standardized testing scores: SAT and/or ACT
8	Please include an electronic photograph in semi-professional attire.
